"Entrepreneurship and Disability" IN COLLABORATION WITH UNIVERSITY OF MURCIA, DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY, SPAIN

A review of research on entrepreneurial activity of people with disabilities has highlighted some important aspects. On one hand, the lower propensity to start up a business as a result of the difficulties facing not only by the limitations of disability, but also the social barriers that must be overcome. On the other hand, the fact that entrepreneurship represents a way of inclusion, visibility and normalization of disabled people. Finally, that it is a collective rising, therefore society is challenged to articulate strategies to facilitate standardization in the economic activity of these people.

The relevance of entrepreneurship and economic activity in general and the special significance acquired as a mean of social integration among this group, suggest the opportunity to address a differentiated analysis.

Of the different variables that have been considered to determine the factors that promote entrepreneurship of disabled people, the competence perspective has not been a sufficiently explored route. This special issue aims to gather papers involving the research that has been done on disabled people and entrepreneurship. Emphasis is given to the identification of the competences that promote or limit entrepreneurship within this group. Authors from different disciplines, such as social sciences, management or economy are invited to submit their papers.
